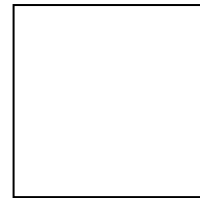

ELIGIBILITY & GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS

1. The scholarship awards shall be open to undergraduate Muslim students in all fields of academic endeavour in Public Universities and Polytechnics in Nigeria.
2. Applicants should ensure that they are actually in need of support to improve their academic performance.
3. Indigent support applicants in year 2 and above must possess a minimum CGPA of 1.50 while CGPA of 3.50 and above is for scholarship applicants.
4. Application Forms should be correctly filled in triplicates. Incomplete or incorrect information disqualifies the applicant.
5. Application for the Indigent Support must be accompanied by a one page hand written submission stating why they need the fund and how it will help improve their current situation. This submission must be attested to as been true by at least one of the referees.
6. Application for the Indigent Support Fund is also open to freshly admitted students.
7. Application is open to only those who are not on any other scholarship programme.
8. Applicants should attach recent passport size photograph and photocopies of:
 - i. WAEC/NECO/SSCE results used in gaining admission into higher institution.
 - ii. JAMB/UTME results
 - iii. Admission letter into higher institution.
9. The Companion Scholarship Award Committee will verify applicant's studentship and academic records. The committee may, at its discretion, schedule and conduct oral interview with candidates.
